Since our founding in 1881, Newton-Wellesley Hospital has played an important role caring for the health and well-being of our community and beyond. While we work to provide outstanding medical care, we ask you to help us raise awareness and funds to address the deepening and deadly substance abuse crisis in our community.

Today, over 20 million Americans suffer from a substance use disorder – almost eight percent of the adolescent and adult population. Whether it is the rapid rise of addiction to prescription opioids, alcohol or other illegal drugs, substance abuse prevents individuals from living healthy and productive lives . . . placing a tremendous burden on families, workplaces and communities.

Every day 80 people die from an opioid overdose nationwide. However, in Massachusetts the rate is even higher causing an average of five deaths per day, nearly 2,000 annually or five times more than those who die in car crashes. Eighty percent of heroin or fentanyl users started by taking prescribed pain medication. This crisis cuts across all boundaries of economic status, race, gender and education level. It is happening at a significant rate in our community.

The Gala goal is to raise \$1 million or more to help establish a multidisciplinary team to provide direct care as well as coordinate with community partners for increased access to education, prevention, treatment and recovery services and end the stigma associated with substance abuse. Addiction can afflict anyone, but recovery is possible with more informed choices of pain management and substance abuse treatment.
