  - » The 15th green



#### **Belmont Country Club Tournament Protocols**

- Teams will tee off every 12 minutes. (There will not be a shotgun start this year.)
- All guests may arrive to the club 45 minutes prior to their assigned tee time. Teams must arrive to the first tee 5 minutes prior to their assigned tee times. Those who arrive earlier must remain in their cars until called by the starter.
- Every guest must enter the club from the main entrance.

- Please park in the front upper left-hand side parking lot by the first tee putting green.
- Club starter will issue each player single rider golf cart.
   Players sharing a common residence may ride together.
- Golf carts will be outfitted with scorecards, pencils and tournament gift items prior to the start of the round.
- Masks must be worn from the parking lot to the range and at

- any time conversing with staff or others.
- Masks may be removed during warm up at the range and while eating.
- Masks may be removed on the course, as long as social distancing can be maintained.
- Masks must be worn when accepting any food/beverage or during contact with club staff.
- Bathrooms are open at the tennis courts, 10th tee and Clubhouse.
- You must enter the clubhouse through the designated doors.
- The Pro Shop is open. Masks must be worn while inside.
- 4-hour pace of play is strictly enforced; any group coming out of compliance will be asked

- to skip hole and proceed to the next teeing ground.
- Upon completion of the golf round, all players should return clubs to their cars and leave the property. If groups sit down after the round and eat, teams should spend no more than 45 minutes at the table.
- Teams will be issued a Go Club team number that will provide live scoring updates throughout the day. One team member will be responsible for downloading the Go Club app and keeping the score on the app.
- In the event of thunderstorms or heavy rain, all players on the course must return carts and proceed to the parking lots, where they must remain in their automobile until notified by club staff.
