Day of Surgery Planner



To Do

- Fill any prescription medications in advance.
- Stock up on food for the days after surgery.
- Set up a comfortable recovery environment at home.
- Don't eat any solid food after midnight before your surgery including gum, candy or mints.
- You may be able to have specific clear liquids up to two hours before surgery time (no orange juice, milk, soda, etc.).
- Confirm your ride home from the hospital—you'll need someone to accompany you.
- Dress for recovery and wear what will feel most comfortable for your trip home.
- □ Remember not to wear anything scented including lotion.



To Bring or Not To Bring

- ☐ If you wear contacts, you'll also need your glasses. Don't forget to bring cases for both!
- Please be sure to leave jewelry or valuables at home.
- ☐ If you wear dentures, please remember your denture case!
- Feel free to bring a book or magazine.
- Remember to bring something that makes you feel relaxed (like a family photo).
- Feel free to bring headphones and a playlist.
