Newton-Wellesley Hospital Patient Information For Stroke or Transient Ischemic Attack (TIA)

Newton-Wellesley Hospital is committed to providing the best possible education and other services to patients recovering from a stroke/TIA, as well as those who are at risk for stroke/TIA. This discharge instruction packet will help you to understand the warning signs and symptoms of stroke/TIA. Also included here are specific preventative measures and services provided by NWH in the event a stroke/TIA has already occurred.

Recovery from a stroke/TIA can be a difficult process. The **Stroke Clinic** at Newton-Wellesley Hospital provides comprehensive services which can make this transition easier.

Who is eligible?

 The NWH Stroke Clinic is offered to patients who have had a stroke or TIA and were admitted to NWH for their evaluation.

Location:

 The Stroke Clinic is located in the Cardiovascular Rehabilitation Department on 2-West.

Availability:

 The Stroke Clinic meets once a month on Fridays from 8am -12 noon. It is traditionally the 4th Friday of the month but this is subject to change depending on holidays.
